ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Leadership Bridge Program is a new pilot program for assistant principal and principal pairs designed to give aspiring principals exposure to the experiences they will need to successfully lead a school in the future.

Current principals will receive individualized coaching on how best to support their assistant principal on their leadership journey.

During the 2019-20 school year, participants will:

- Receive individualized coaching from an external partner on how to improve management skills and lead high-performing teams.
- Take the Val-Ed leadership diagnostic and create a personalized leadership development action plan with their principal and coach, which will be linked to specific strategies that drive increased outcomes for students.
- Build relationships with their peers within the learning community.
 They will also work with their principal and leadership coach to expand their relationship management skills within their school community.
- Work with external coaches to gain exposure to adaptive leadership and responsiveness in their own role and in a future principal position.
